





The cause of cancer is still unknown. But there are certain factors which have been found to be cancer prone.

**Smoking**: One-third of cancer deaths are caused

by smoking-related reasons. Smokers are more prone to cancer of throat, larynx, lung, liver, uterus etc.

# Know Cancer, Cancer Fight Cancer

### What is cancer?

The word cancer originated from the Latin 'Cancrum' which means crab. Human body consists of innumerable living cells, cancer also consists of cells. After birth a child grows up as per the laws of cells nature. But they never grow up in a disorderly fashion but maintain a definite and controlled order to meet the demand of the body. The cancer cells, however grow up at random – sometimes deep into the spot of the origin and sometimes spreads to other parts of the body. Cancer can attack any part of the body as well as any type of cells.

### General categorization of cancer:

Categorization of cancer is done on the basis of the type of cells that create the disease. For example :

- 1. Carcinoma originates from Epithelial tissue like breast, lung etc.
- 2. Sarcoma originates from bone, mussles etc.

Quid (raw tobacco): Its connection with cancer of liver, mouth and larynx has been well proved.

**Liquor**: To much of drinking can cause cancer in larynx, liver and ever rectum.

Food habit: It plays an important role to keep cancer at bay. Fat should be avoided and preference be given to food containing fibre. Beef, too much of milk or milk products and the chemicals used

in food preservation increase the risk of cancer. On the other hand vegetable, fresh fruits, fibre-rich grains contain, anti -cancer ingredients.

Profession: People engaged in different professions are found to suffer from different types of cancer. Benzine, arsenic, chromium, asbestos, cadmium etc. may cause cancer. X-ray clinic technicians, therefore, run more risks than others.

Untidy habits: Untidy environment as

Heredity: Cancer's connection with genealogy is a proven fact. People with same heredity suffer from same type of cancer. That is why leukaemia is more prevalent among Mongolians than any other types of cancer.





## Modern trends in Cancer treatment

[Has cancer an answer? yes, asserts Dr. Gazi G. Ahmed in this concluding part of his article]

After successful rounds of radiotherapy and chemotherapy cancer can recur but in this occasion it is due to the inherent resistance in the cancer cells. The sensitivity of cancer cells to radiotherapy and chemotherapy can be predicted to some extent from a detailed biopsy report which is mandatory for the diagnosis of cancer and for prediction regarding sensitivity. It is, therefore, obvious that surgery remains the ideal treatment for cancer provided the

disease is detected early and limited to the site of origin. Unfortunately it happens very

rarely for lack of awareness amongst the people about cancer. This apart, cancer inside the body shows symptoms rather late and by the time it is detected it spreads to distant organs.

In some cases cancer grows abutting vital organs where

surgery is not possible even in a very early stage. Here radiotherapy might salvage the patient provided the cancer cells are sensitive to ionizing radiation like x-ray and gamma ray. Sometimes if the surgeon has

doubt regarding complete uprooting of the cancer mass he may send for radiotherapy to kill the cancer cells remaining in the tumour bed. Too much delay in resorting to radiotherapy might defeat the purpose. When the disease is everywhere like leukemia, lymphoma and

sometime metastases from a sensitive primary cancer, chemotherapy remains the only modality for treatment.





## Breast cancer up, Cervical cancer down

Surveys state that Cervical Cancer in Indian women has started showing a steady line of decrease. This is definitely a hopeful phenomenon. On the other hand, however, the

incidence of breast cancer has been increasing by leaps and bounds all over India. The Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), after medical research in Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Bangalore for 24 years from 1982 to 2005, have come to know that the rate of cervical cancer has certainly decreased by about 40 per cent but breast cancer rate has gone up double-fold.

These trends, contained in ICMR's yet—
to-be-released report Time Trends in Cancer Incidence Rates
(1982–2005), were universal in all four cities.

Reasons for fall in number of cervical cancer:

- Personal health consciousness
- Cleanliness
  - Late marriage
  - And less number of child birth.

Reasons for rise in number of breast cancer:

- Western life-style
- Late marriage
- Late pregnancy
- Excessive intake of salt and fat containing food
- Apathy to have child
- Depriving child of breast feed
- Excessive use of contraceptives



## Conscious Surgery

Some common foods may promote cancer whereas some foods are there in this beautiful nature that can fight against cancers and also prevent cancer. In fact, these food-stuffs contain cancer-fighting properties or agents. Of course there is no such single element in a particular food which can perform all the works. That is why we should take a variety of foods in general.

Broccoli, Cabbage and Cauliflower contain an anti-cancer agent known as indole-3-carbinol which can prevent breast cancer.

Carrots have beta carotene that can combat cancers of lung, oral

cavity, stomach, colon, urinary bladder and prostate.

Garlic contains allicin, an anti-cancer agent which can prevent gastrointestinal cancers. It acts against helicobacter pylori, a known promoter of stomach cancer.

There are some mushrooms which contain a protein known as lectin that can attack cancer-cells and prevent them from multiplying.

Grapes have resveratrol that protects from cancers of breast, liver and colon.

Tomato contains lycopene that can Some forms of nuts, sea fish, rice, wheat contain an anti-cancer mineral like selenium that certainly prevents cancer of breast, colon and prostate.

Turmeric contains curcumin which

can stop cancer in its earliest stages long before it is detectable.

Oranges contain Vitamin-C that can prevent normal cell to be transformed into cancerous one.

Soyabean contains phytoestrogen which can prevent breast cancer by maintaining the estrogen level normal in the body.

So we should take varieties of fruits and vegetables so that we can fight against cancers.

Body influences at the multidimensional level to be in health are humoral (tridosha-tridhatu three types), tissue ( seven dhatus), system channels (thirteen types srotas), metabolic (agni), excretory, psyche and conscious. If any imbalance takes place, body in its own language speaks about somatic status through symptoms symbolically. If we can decode the massage we can come to a grater understanding about the person experiencing imbalances. When the ongoing process of energy is freezes the body starts emitting alarming signals on the stress produced. In the treatment of cancer energy shift from plants are very important.


