



that Prateek has no ailment. He is fine now. That is why we did not feel it necessary to go in for CT Scan.

"We wish D.S. Research Centre to grow leaps and bounds, so that more and more benefit". (Reference-68).

In its reply, the D.S. Research Centre said that it would be good if the CT scan was done. On 26.11.95, CT scan was done at Sarvodaya Medical Research Centre, Delhi (CT 15345/95). The report was very encouraging. (Reference-69)

The boy is now in a state of health where the fear of the recurrence

of disease is allayed. It appears that the medicine will be discontinued with the recovery from the disease. The medicine, however, is continuing as a precautionary measure.

According to the letter of Sri. Rajesh Kumar, the uncle of Prateek dated 01.11.96, the boy is completely in good health and agile; goes to school and takes the medicine at intervals. (Reference-70)

Everyone is aware of the ferocity and the rapid speech with which Sarcoma spreads, leaving the treatment and steps for its control far behind. In each Sarcoma had spread its tentacles upto the lung. That was checked there and now Prateek is leading a carefree daily life. Months have passed; years have elapsed his life is stable and circumstances favourable. Now there is no reason to disbelieve that the danger has blown over and Prateek has sured permanent victory over Sarcoma.

In his letter dated 17.07.97, Sri. Rajesh Kumar wrote, “Prateek is fine. He is lating properly. He also goes to school. He is bodily fit.” (Reference- 71)

On 14.12.97, Sri Ashok Kumar Bansal reported that Prateek is in good health.

Though the results historic, yet the success is still refreshing. An alert eye has to be put on fluctuations. Similarly, a close watch has to be maintained on the treatment. One must have waited for sometimes more before stating anything specific about the successful treatment of cancer. However, a brief account of the victory of man over deadly cancer, is given here. Making adjustment between science and man does not turn unscientific. Our feet are firmly put on the front of science, but it is also necessary to carve out a place for human sensibilities.

“.....We are very much concerned. The doctors have set the time from six months to one year. We are very much anxious. The doctors do not say this out of enmity nor do day speak bullshit. Whatever they speak is based on the symptoms of the body. They examine the patient and then diagnose him. They are well aware of the limitations of the medical science. They state on the strength of that.

The father of the 13 year old Master Shishir wrote this letter to D.S. Research Centre on 16.21.96, when the six months period had been completed and the wait for the next six months began. This is the compulsion of life that one has to enter the dark alley pf alley of anxiety, though unwillingly.

The one year deadline, each day of which had haunted the family, passed. Though the disease with which Shishir was afflicted, had shown the signs of decline, health improved, health-related problems abated and he had become active and agile, the apprehensions did not fully die out. All the reports tested negative. Despite everything being negative, apprehensions persisted. Whenever reminded of the statements of the doctors, the consciousness took a nose dive. Those moments were full of fearness lest a misfortune showed overtake and all the hopes of life were belied.

Master Shishir's father again met the doctors to fine out what they had now to say. The doctors who had predicted life for six months or one year only were now also witness to a new lease of life. They had never imagined that the doses of nourishing energy would take over and convert the shadow of death into a celebration of life.

Family members were fully convinced that now Shishir's life was out of danger, and his victory over cancer was confirmed. On 22.07.97, Shishir's father, Sri. Dileep Mokati informed with overwhelmed sentiments that his son had cleared the Board Examination. (Reference-58).

His family members were very sceptic towards the end of the year. Though the Apollo Hospital had clarified on 21.03.97 that there was no trace tumour nor the recurrence of disease (Reference -57), several medical experts were consulted.



for some time. The doctors had at this stage explained to his father that his son's life could not last more than six months or one year.

### **Towards "Sarvapishti"**

During these turbulent times, Sri. R.K. Maheshwari came to know about the crisis. It was Sri. Maheshwari, who had arranged the 'Sarvapishti' for his mother-in-law, Smt. Annapurna Maheshwari, a resident of Bharthana, under the similar critical condition, from D.S. Research Centre, Varanasi. The patient had recovered from liver cancer and is now leading a normal life for sometime. He himself contacted the D.S. Research Centre, with test reports and obtained the "Sarvapishti" from there. The biopsy report was awaited, but the "Sarvapishti" was started to be given soon after its arrival.

### **'Sarvapishti' was started from 21.6.96**

Sarvapishti was regularly taken and the radio-therapy course completed in July/August. The doctors of the Apollo Hospital had informed that nothing except radio-therapy is possible, and radiation too could no longer be extended.

The 'Sarvapishti' was now the only option: It was being regularly given. Relief on the basis of symptoms was discernible. Reports received from time to time.

06.06.96: "Health is improving. There is no headache. Weakness of hands and feet has also improved. Obliquity of the mouth has also improved."

18.09.96: "Feel headache sometimes. Rest is fine. He also goes to school sometimes. M.R.I. report dated 19.09.96 also indicated some improvement." (Reference 60)

Dr. Stomph of the Apollo Hospital got the M.R.I. (No. 689/M.R.I.) of brain done on 19.09.96. The size of legion was found to have significantly diminished with signs of fast improvement. Though the size diminished, yet the tumour was present.

17.02.97: Neuro-surgeon, Dr. Ram Murti was consulted 4-5 days ago. Satisfied with the test reports of eyes and urine, he did not see immediate need for M.R.I.

11.03.97: “By the grace of God and with your support, his health has improved a lot. I am also enclosing the report of the M.R.I. which was done by the doctors of the Apollo Cancer Hospital on February 28. According to the doctors, cancer cells are not visible in the report.”

Master Shishir is now studying and playing with is class- mates and those of his age enthusiastically. After seeing him, nobody can guess that he ever was suffering from cancer. Nor is there any symptom of cancer in him. Internal tests also show no signs of cancer. Doses of nourishing energy also continued subsequently.

Sri Dileep, in his letter dated 29.11.97, informed of Shishir having fully recovered. (Reference- 62).
